Employment

“What would you like to do to make sure that employment barriers are lessened or eliminated for people with disabilities?”

- Mr. White suggests increasing the income and asset limits by small steps to allow individuals to have a greater range of opportunities without losing most of their benefits.

Transportation

“Transportation is difficult in many rural communities, regardless of disability. What will you do to address accessible transportation needs for people with disabilities?”

- Mr. White suggests using successful transportation methods for people with disabilities in some communities to expand to more rural areas.
- Mr. White strongly supports individuals with disabilities having opportunities that include accessible transportation.

Home and Community Based Services

“What would you do to increase the availability of Home and Community Based Services (HCBS)?”

- Mr. White supports HCBS and group home programs.
- He would substantially limit the time that individuals wait to get waiver services to improve their level of housing security.

Healthcare

“What could you do to improve understanding and sensitivity for clinicians regarding disabilities, and ultimately for everyone?”

- Mr. White would make sure that professionals receive the education they need, particularly in relation to disability rights, right to life, and quality of life.

Housing


“What could you do to increase the affordability and availability of housing for people with disabilities?”

- Mr. White would work to help individuals receive housing coupons quickly, as well as getting them off a waiting list and into housing faster.
- Mr. White believes in expanding government financially supported housing opportunities to keep families together.
